- Ensure public involvement at all critical stages, from initial design to ongoing property management;
- · Consider options for economically-feasible uses of this site; and
- Involve as much of the community as possible regarding all potential developments and/or uses of the space.

FoCS believes that:

- Columbia School has been in the public land trust since the 1920s, and this site should be developed for public purposes to the extend possible;
- The ethnic and economic diversity of Columbia City should be preserved and promoted when deciding on the future use of this site; and
- A fair and transparent process of deciding what to do with the site is paramount.
